This week I want to introduce you to our seminarian who will be with us for the summer. He is Deacon Miguel Melendez.

When you are trying to become a priest, it is a 6 or 7 year process after undergraduate college. The year before you are ordained a priest, you get ordained as a deacon.

Miguel was just ordained a deacon about a month ago and is hoping to be ordained to the priesthood June 2017.
