THE PASTOR'S WEEKLY REFLECTION/ REFLEXIÓN SEMANAL DEL PASTOR

As we start a new liturgical year and anticipate the welcoming of Christ into the world with the Feast of the Incarnation, we're mindful that His Birth is a resetting of humanity, an ushering in of a new age.

It is a reminder that we do not have to be determined by our sin, by our pasts, if we are willing to learn the way of spiritual childhood. St. Therese is the modern exemplar of this mode of spirituality in the life of the Church.

Among many reflections we could point to, maybe consider just one:

"Everything is a grace, everything is the direct effect of our Father's love - difficulties, contradictions, humiliations, all the soul's miseries, her burdens, her needs - everything, because through them, she learns humility, realizes her weakness. Everything is a grace because everything is God's gift. Whatever be the character of life or its unexpected events - to the heart that loves, all is well."

Do you allow yourself to live this way? Maybe consider making a daily resolution this season to learn how to see that each moment is a grace that can be offered back to the Lord with love.

Please consider ways in which you can become more involved in the community, or at least taking a little bit of time this season to prepare for the Feast of the Incarnation, beyong family celebrations. Consider how you might put your spiritual life in order and participate in one or more of the various opportunities provided throughout our communities and the wider region.

¿Te permites vivir de esta manera? Tal vez considere hacer una resolución diaria durante esta temporada para aprender a ver que cada momento es una gracia que se puede ofrecer al Señor con amor.

Por favor, considere maneras en las que puede involucrarse más en la comunidad, o al menos tomarse un poco de tiempo durante esta temporada para prepararse para la Fiesta de la Encarnación, más allá de las celebraciones familiares. MUSIC AT SAINT PATRICK & SAINT JOHN

Today we begin the new liturgical year with Advent. May this time of "less," remind us that the preparatory time we are in is meant to call us toward the Lord that we await, in thanksgiving and repentance.

Social Ministry: This week, we fed over 322 guests a hot meal, 13 guests utilized the showers, 72 guests utilized the clothing closet, 12 bags of groceries plus 20 snack bags were given out to those in need.

Sacristans at Daily Mass: I need assistance in closing the Church on Fridays and other days when I am able to assist at Mass at Saint Peter. If you are able to help please let me know. - <u>Fr. Capuano</u>

Activity around the parish: As you may have noticed, we have continued work on the exterior grounds of the parish. Principally, we noticed issues with the plumbing and moisture on the east exterior of the building, prompting some much needed work on the drainage. This led to discovering a new sleeping spot for some of our city visitors. In the next couple of months we will continue working to clean up the east side of the property, install security fencing near the Upper Room and continue to address the trash problem and issues related to late-night use of the property (folks using the property, particularly out-of-the way areas as a restroom). Additionally, we will be addressing some moisture and mold issues on the west side of the building in the basement, which will require a temporary relocation of our food storage and the installation of dehumidifiers and a sump pump near the west wall in the basement along Grace Street. Thank you for your patience and generosity as we continue to protect our historic church and strive to provide for the needs of those who have so little. I'm so grateful for the generosity of so many who make assistance available to the needy. - Fr. Capuano
