MUSIC AT SAINT PATRICK & SAINT JOHN

For the upcoming celebrations of Christmas Eve and Christmas Day, the Ordinary of the Mass (Lord have Mercy, Glory to God, Holy, Lamb of God) will be sung in Latin. The melodies are the same as those we sang in English, during Ordinary Time. These are the missal chants that the priest sees at the altar each Sunday. The text of what will be sung is in Latin, but the music is the same as that of the English.

It is helpful to recall how the Saints worshipped God, while here on earth and put our own perspective of Sacred Music and liturgical practices into the context of the broader Church history, rather than just within our lifetime. From the time of Saint Jerome (4th c.), the church has utilized Latin as the primary language in which to worship God. It is, in part, for this reason that the Second Vatican Council addresses the continuance of the singing of Latin in the Mass Ordinary when it says, "Steps should be taken so that the faithful may also be able to say or to sing together in Latin those parts of the Ordinary of the Mass which pertain to them." The vernacular language of the people is also important to the council fathers, but Sacrosanctum Concilium (1963) seems to be clear, at least in reference to the Ordinary of the Mass, that Latin ought to be preserved.

May we welcome Our Lord with our best efforts in worship and love him all the more through the tradition of His bride, the Church!

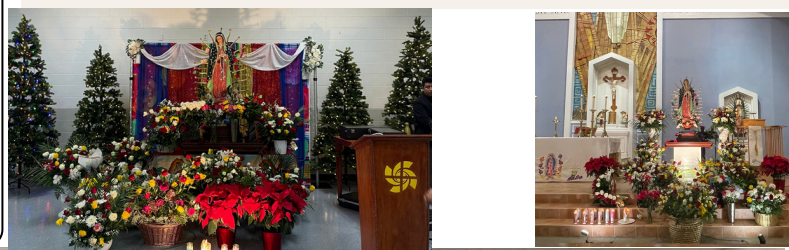




