**THE PASTOR'S WEEKLY REFLECTION/ REFLEXIÓN SEMANAL DEL PÁRROCO**

As we celebrate the great feast of the Most Holy Trinity, we are challenged by the Apostle to the Gentiles. He reminds us that “the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us.” The Lord is working *actively* to keep us in His Heart.

Young people sometimes speak of “love-bombing” another person, where affection has been ramped up, which might distract us, positively, from ailments, or negatively, from the deficiencies in the other. In the Lord’s case, He has definitely overwhelmed us with His love, and continues to overwhelm us that we might be “distracted” from getting too stuck on our sinful states. We can “boast of our afflictions,” because it is through our weakness that the Lord gives strength. He invites us to point out our weakness, to not be ashamed of our littleness, so that His grace has “more room” to work. Here, I’m reminded of little line from St. Therese of Lisieux: “Do not fear to tell Jesus that you love Him even without feeling it. That is the way to force Jesus to help you, to carry you like a little child too feeble to walk.”

En el caso del Señor, Él definitivamente nos ha colmado de su amor y continúa colmándonos para que nos distraigamos y no nos obsesionemos demasiado con nuestros estados pecaminosos. Podemos jactarnos de nuestras aflicciones, porque es a través de nuestra debilidad que el Señor nos fortalece. Nos invita a señalar nuestra debilidad, a no avergonzarnos de nuestra pequeñez, para que su gracia tenga más espacio para obrar. Aquí, recuerdo una pequeña frase de Santa Teresita de Lisieux: «No temas decirle a Jesús que lo amas, incluso sin sentirlo. Así es como logras que Jesús te ayude, que te lleve como un niño pequeño demasiado débil para caminar».
