THE ADMINISTRATOR'S WEEKLY REFLECTION/ REFLEXIÓN SEMANAL DEL ADMINISTRATOR

In the Gospel this Sunday, Jesus shows us the need to balance action and contemplation. Martha was busy with work, while Mary chose to sit at Jesus' feet and listen. Jesus gently reminds us that prayer must come first. This reflects the wisdom of ora et labora—"pray and work"—a principle lived by the Benedictines. Mary chose ora, the life of prayer, reminding us that before we serve others, we must first be nourished by God's Word.

Work without prayer becomes restless; prayer without action can become empty. Ora et labora teaches us that both are needed for a holy and fruitful life. When we begin our day with prayer and offer our labor to God, we find peace and purpose. Like Mary and Martha, we are called to serve, but always with hearts rooted in prayerful listening.

En el Evangelio de este domingo, Jesús nos muestra la necesidad de equilibrar la acción y la contemplación. Marta estaba ocupada con el trabajo, mientras que María eligió sentarse a los pies de Jesús y escuchar. Jesús nos recuerda con dulzura que la oración debe venir primero. Esto refleja la sabiduría de ora et labora —"reza y trabaja"—, un principio vivido por los benedictinos. María eligió ora, la vida de oración, recordándonos que antes de servir a los demás, debemos ser alimentados por la Palabra de Dios.

El trabajo sin oración se vuelve inquieto; la oración sin acción puede volverse vacía. Ora et labora nos enseña que ambos son necesarios para una vida santa y fecunda. Cuando comenzamos nuestro día con oración y ofrecemos nuestro trabajo a Dios, encontramos paz y propósito. Como María y Marta, estamos llamados a servir, pero siempre con un corazón enraizado en la escucha orante.

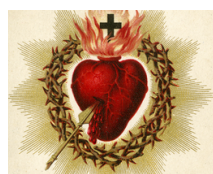
